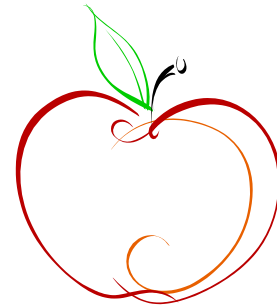

This scholarship is intended for a non-voting, ***non-farm*** family within the associate membership of OFBF. Student must be preparing to continue his/her education through a junior college, or a four-year college or university with intent to seek a bachelor's degree.
