Purpose

Linn County Farm Bureau is promoting involvement with education in agriculture, leadership, and attracting new students to agriculture, thus promoting an agriculture future.

Eligibility

Linn County Farm Bureau Scholarship is made available to any resident of Linn County, at a time of application, who is interested in pursuing a career in agriculture or one of its related fields.

Award Amount

The scholarship may be up to \$1,000 on a yearly academic basis to Linn County high school graduates, returning students, transfer students, and to prior recipients.

Criteria

- Linn County resident
- Choice of college
- Major in agriculture or one of its related fields
- GPA of 2.8 or GED score
- Full time student (12 credit/qtr., minimum)
- SAT/ACT score (or other test)
- Official Transcripts from most recent school attended (High School or College)
- Two (2) letters of recommendation are required.
One letter must be from an Ag Advisor or Teacher and one personal letter from a non-relative.
Please include them with your application.
- Applicant's written statement as to reason for agriculture profession desired
Include your experiences in leadership, in community service and in Agriculture
(For example: farm experience, 4-H, FFA and other Ag related fields)
